- Must be a degree-seeking UA student, enrolled in a University of Arizona Study Abroad and Student Exchange sponsored program.
- Minimum 3.5 GPA.

SASE TRAVEL GRANT PERSONAL STATEMENT

The SASE Travel Grant Personal Statement is the most important factor of your application, so please take the time to read over the directions carefully.

PERSONAL STATEMENT DIRECTIONS:

All essays should be typed, double-spaced and should not exceed the length of 1 page. The essay should not include your name, student ID, the name of your intended study abroad program, or the name of the country you plan to study to ensure total anonymity for the reviewing process. Please provide 2 copies of your Personal Statement with your application.

Essays will be judged on the overall quality of the essay, including grammar, spelling, length, and how well the writer addressed the questions below.

Your essay should address the following questions:

- 1. What are your specific academic reasons for selecting your study abroad program?
- 2. How do you believe that study abroad will contribute to your goals academically and personally?
- 3. How will you fulfill your role as an informal "ambassador" of both the University of Arizona and the United States during your time abroad on your program?

Before submitting your application, please check that you have completed all materials. Please note that dismissal or withdraw from your selected study abroad program will result in you being responsible for repayment of the Travel Grant.
